03	Product Sampling Sample packs dispatched with Certificate of Analysis. Buyers are encouraged to conduct independent testing prior to first commercial order.
04	Quotation & Negotiation Formal proforma invoice issued with unit pricing, Incoterms, validity period, and payment terms (L/C and T/T supported).
05	Production & Quality Check Pre-shipment quality inspection with full batch documentation. Third-party inspection available on request.
06	Export Documentation & Dispatch Goods dispatched from Apapa/Lagos with full documentation package. All paperwork provided digitally ahead of vessel arrival.
07	Delivery & Partnership Delivery confirmed. Repeat buyer terms, standing orders, and preferred partner pricing available for buyers with confirmed order history.
